### **ID Card For Students**

The students must always wear the school ID card during school hours. Students are instructed not to exchange / borrow the ID card of another student.

### **For The Special Attention of The Parents:-**

The school management always needs your co-operation in its effort to provide the best education to your ward and to maintain excellence in the field of teaching and discipline. While appreciating your concern for this institution, I wish to call upon your attention to the following disciplinary matters for which your support is very much needed.

1. Kindly go through the School Diary thoroughly and observe the school disciplinary rules and the code of conduct expected from the parents and students.
2. Irregular attendance, habitual indiscipline, lack of interest in studies and acts of insubordination towards the staff and the principal etc. will be considered as a grave offence.
3. Please ensure that your ward does not miss the class for simple reasons. As per the CBSE norms, 75% attendance is compulsory.
4. Please ensure that your ward attends the school in proper uniform. This rule applies even when they come to school for any purpose or even after school hours. Scribbling on uniform or its improper wear is punishable.
5. Any change in your address or mobile number is to be informed in the school office and the same should be entered in the student's diary.
6. PTM is held on regular basis for evaluation of Academic and Non-Academic performance of the student. It is mandatory for all the parents to attend the PTM to help the teachers to cultivate moral values as well as to improve academic performance of the students.
7. Students are not allowed to bring electronic goods, mobile phones, sharp material and fancy ornaments to the school.



8. Students, who are sick, should not be sent to the school to attend the classes or to take tests as it would amount to unnecessary strain on them and would adversely affect their health and studies.
9. Students are not allowed to go out or to be taken from the school, during the school hours, except during unforeseen circumstances.
10. Show unwavering support, positive reinforcement for your child's performance and effort.

#### **Regarding Transportation of Wards**

Safety and security of children while in the school and during their transportation to and fro, are of paramount importance and concern for us and you, the parents. So together let us make efforts to ensure the safety of our children. Parents are earnestly requested to discourage their wards to bring their private conveyance to school. School Buses are plying from every nook and corner of the city. They must avail that.

#### **KINDLY ADVISE YOUR CHILDREN**

2. Not to get down anywhere on the way from the vehicle other than the place of residence from where they were picked up.
